- 2026 **SproSS - Indicators review and update.**
The project aims to improve the monitoring system of the Provincial Strategy for Sustainable Development by revising and expanding the corresponding set of provincial indicators. FBK-IRVAPP works with the Provincial Agency for Environmental Protection and the Statistical Institute of the Autonomous Province of Trento, which planned the revision of the existing indicator system.
- 2025-2026 **SMART SCHOOLS Greece**
The project supports the Greek Ministry of Education, Religious Affairs and Sports in developing a comprehensive monitoring and evaluation framework for digital education investments. The project is coordinated by European Schoolnet.
